GATE - 2012

Examination Type:

The GATE examination consists of a single paper of **3 Hours** duration which contains **65 questions** carrying a maximum of **100 marks**. The question paper will consist of only objective questions. The examination for the papers with codes AE, AG, AR, GG, MN and TF will be carried out ONLINE using computers where the candidates will be required to enter the answer for each question using mouse. For all other papers, the candidates will have to mark the correct choice on an Optical Response Sheet (ORS) by darkening the appropriate bubble against each question. In the papers bearing the codes AE, AG, BT, CE, CH, CS, EC, EE, IN, ME, MN, MT, PI, TF and XE, the **Engineering Mathematics** will carry **15 %** of the total marks, the **General Aptitude section** will carry **15 %** of the total marks and **the remaining 70 %** of the **total marks** is devoted to the subject of the paper.

There will be Negative marking for each wrong answer, as detailed below:

For 1 mark multiple choice questions, 1/3 mark will be deducted for a wrong answer. Likewise, for 2 marks multiple choice questions, 2/3 mark will be deducted for a wrong answer. However, for the linked answer question pair, where each question carries 2 marks, 2/3 mark will be deducted for a wrong answer to the first question only. There is no negative marking for wrong answer to the second question of the linked answer question pair. If the first question in the linked pair is wrongly answered or is unattempted, then the answer to the second question in the pair will not be evaluated. There is no negative marking for Numerical Type of Questions.

Note: GATE 2012 score is valid for **2 YEARS** from the date of announcement of the GATE 2012 results.
